Public notice is hereby given that the Board of Equalization for Louisa County will meet in the upcoming weeks for the purpose of hearing complaints of inequalities. Upon hearing such complaints, either oral or written, the Board will give consideration and INCREASE, DECREASE, OR AFFIRM such real estate assessments. The taxpayer or agent must prove that the property is not uniform with other similar properties or prove that the property is assessed in excess of its fair market value.

Appointments will be scheduled every 30 minutes consecutively. To appear before the Board of Equalization, please call (540)967-3450, between the hours of 8:30 am to 5:00 pm for an application.

All property owners wishing to be heard must file an application for a hearing on or before **April 23, 2018**. **Any property owner who fails to meet the filing deadline will not be heard pursuant to Section 70-118 of the Louisa County Code.**

All hearings will be held in the Executive Board Room of the County Administration Building. The dates and times will be listed in the Central Virginian once scheduled.
