Minutes of April 8th, 2019 Meeting

The Louisa County Electoral Board met on Monday, April 8th, 2019, in the Administration Room of the Louisa County Office Building. Present were Mr. Haymore, Mr. Koegle, and Mrs. Watkins. (Mrs. Wolf was provided an excused absence.)

Call to Order, Quorum Established

Mr. Haymore declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m.

Open Session

Following an Agenda review with topics regarding a review of the April 1st equipment demonstration provided by DEMTECH and a proposed challenge to increase Voter participation in elections.

The Minutes for the Tuesday, March 8th, 2019 Electoral Board meeting were approved with exception of a spelling error. The error is to be corrected prior to a final approved posting.

During the previous Louisa Electoral Board meeting of March 8th, Mr. Haymore requested Mr. Koegle contact the Louisa County Board of Supervisors regarding the resolution forwarded to Mr. Christian Goodwin. Mr. Koegle followed up on the request. The Louisa County Board of Supervisors voiced their opinion that the current compensation provided was higher than the compensation provided by neighboring Virginia counties and that no further increase was recommended.

Registrar's Report: Mrs. Watkins

Mis-assigned Voters – SB 1102 did not pass – awaiting an understanding from the Louisa County Attorney regarding Para. B path forward for 101 voters along Goochland line.

All ADA outside poll bells have been ordered and received. 20,000 regular “I VOTED” stickers will be purchased.
