FAQ

- ❖ How do I make application for the placement of regulatory markers or “no wake” buoys at my cove?

If you would like to request the placement of “no wake” buoys or other regulatory markers, please complete a [Buoy Application](#) and submit all necessary documentation to the County Administration Office. The application packet includes important details and the complete process, which typically takes about 2 to 3 months.

- ❖ Who is responsible for the maintenance of a community regulatory marker and maintenance or replacement of a damaged or missing regulatory marker?

Maintenance on uniform waterway markers shall be assumed by the agency or individual who made application, not the locality or Lake Anna Advisory Committee. All markers shall be maintained in proper condition.

- ❖ Once a buoy has been approved and installed, can it be moved to an alternative location?

Written approval of the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries must be obtained before effecting the relocation of any marker. If any regulatory marker is removed by the permittee for any reason, the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries shall be notified within 10 days of such removal.

- ❖ Who is to be notified if a regulatory marker is damaged or missing?

The Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries should be notified of any damaged or missing waterway markers on the public waters (cold side) of Lake Anna. Any marker or buoy which is not in conformance with the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries regulations may be removed.
