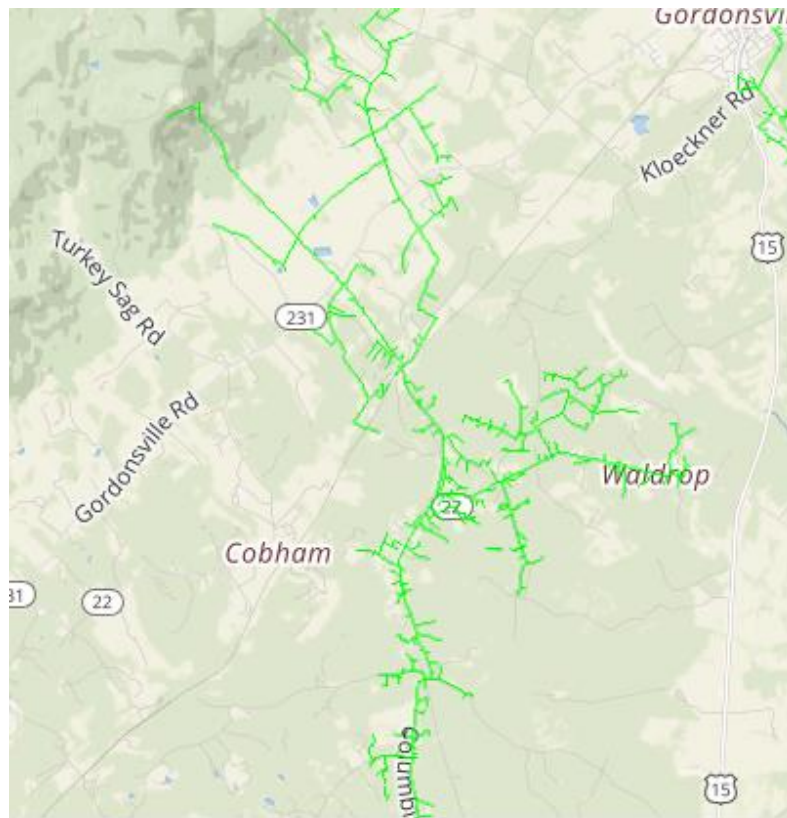


The Central Virginian to publish on November 29th



Louisa and Albemarle Counties are planning to apply for a Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) 2019 Virginia Telecommunication Initiative grant to enhance sustainability and competitive advantages of communities throughout the Commonwealth by preparing those communities to build, utilize, and capitalize on telecommunications infrastructure. This grant will fund Central Virginia Electric Cooperative to install fiber to the household in the area surrounding the Cashes Corner substation in western Louisa County and parts of Albemarle and a separate area south of Batesville in Albemarle County.

The intended Broadband Projects are located in the areas between Cobham, Cashes Corner and Waldrop Rds served by CVEC along Louisa. Lindsay, Columbia and various smaller roads
